

# Activity: Suncatcher

## THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

- 10" Paper plate
- Scissors
- Marker or Pen
- Clear contact paper
- Tissue paper, color variety pack
- Hole-punch
- 6" length of string

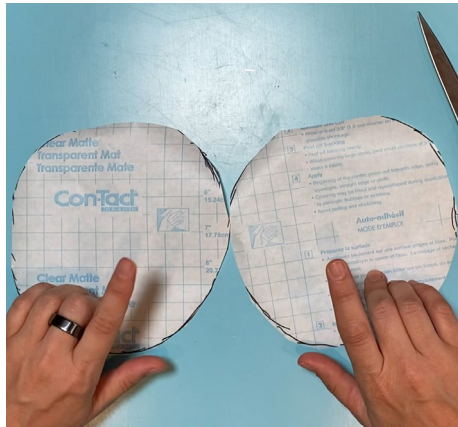


Young children may need help setting up this project. Older children familiar with scissors can set it up with adult supervision.



### Step 1

Cut out the center of your paper plate. Follow the plate's circular impression as a guide.



### Step 2

Cut out 2 contact paper circles that are larger than the new hole in the plate's center.



### Step 3

Peel the backing from a contact paper circle. Attach it to your paper plate, covering the hole.



### Step 4

Press torn or cut tissue paper to the sticky part of the contact paper. Create a mountain scene!



### Step 5

Peel the backing from the other contact paper circle, and stick it on the plate, sandwiching the tissue paper and plate between circles.



### Step 6

Punch a hole into the paper plate frame, using the hole-punch. Put the string through the hole and tie a knot to make a hanging loop.
